Junior Competitions and Starter categories

- Junior Competitions: riders must be 17 years of age or under as at 1st January of the current year
- 12 and Under Competitions: riders must be 12 years of age or under as at 1st January of the current year.
- Starter classes (Junior/Senior) are for riders who have not ridden more than 3 dressage tests (not including Preparatory tests), either closed restricted or official classes.
- The Open Green Horse classes are for horses that have never competed in any competitive EA, pony club or western dressage test.

HOW MANY TESTS?

Horses in Preliminary to Advanced competitions may only enter and compete in a maximum of three tests per day.

Horses may only compete in 2 consecutive levels; Prelim/Novice, Novice/Elem. etc. (Exception is Open Warm up Preparatory Test)

WHAT TO WEAR

A sleeved shirt with collar, or ATDDEA club shirt; Jodhpurs – of any colour; Gloves must be worn (any colour); Other gear as per EA rules (New Members – Rules can be found here – Go to our website www.tablelandsdressage.com.au/forms/ or

ATTENDANCE

Due to COVID 19 restrictions can riders please keep the number of people accompanying them (i.e. family members, strapper, coach, friends) to a minimum and please provide their names and contact details in the email along with your entry form.

PARKING

Club members can park their floats in front of the main horse yards or out the back near the toilets but not on the grass on the eastern side of the entry road, where the dressage arenas are located. Please reverse park closest to the yards and avoid erecting a tent in areas where a car and float could park.

CAMPING

Camping is permitted Camping fee \$10 per adult (18yrs and over). Flat fee

GEAR CHECK

All riders must obtain a gear check when mounted and before each test. All riders or horse owners must complete a **Horse Health Biosecurity form** and hand it in at gear check before riding their first test.

ENTERING AND LEAVING THE GROUNDS

All ATDDEA riders, family members, strappers, coach or friends must sign in at gear check upon arrival and must sign out when leaving, including when leaving and returning to the grounds during the day i.e. to go down the road to purchase lunch or coffee etc.

FACILITIES

Toilets and showers are provided. Only 2 people can access the toilets at one time.

FOOD & BEVERAGES

Please BYO food and drinks. Due to the COVID 19 requirements set out under the Qld Government's Return to Activities Plan, food and beverages will not be available at this event. Riders will need to be self-sufficient.

FURTHER COVID 19 guidelines will be provided when the schedule is sent out. These guidelines will be consistent with the QLD Gov's Return to Activities Plan.

A schedule will be developed and emailed prior to the event.

IMPORTANT

Club Membership - Please note for insurance purposes Club Membership must be paid prior to this event. A Dangerous Activity Form must be completed along with membership.

(Restricted Membership can be taken out for one weekend in a year only (\$30) after which Full Membership can be purchased at discounted rate).
