This event will be held in accordance with current <u>EA Dressage Rules</u> effective 01 January 2025 and any subsequent amendments and ATDDEA rules and policies.

The ATDDEA committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event on the program without notice.

All riders must be aware of the rules surrounding <u>Horse Welfare</u> and the role of Stewards and Marshalls at all ATDDEA events. <u>EA Dressage Rules</u> Sections 1 & 6.

Riders must be aware of the recent EA rulings banning clipping/shaving or modifying sensory hairs (whiskers) or removing or shortening the hair within the rims of the auricle (ears).

Horses may only compete in 2 consecutive levels; Prep/Prelim, Prelim/Novice, Novice/Elem. etc.

Horse can enter and compete in no more than 3 tests in one day. This may include a Freestyle Test. FEI only two tests.

The Draw position/s cannot be changed without the permission of the ATDDEA Organising Committee.

To be eligible for a Championship Event award/s, closed restricted competitors must have competed in one other ATDDEA competition that same year.

All riders must complete and hand in a Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration Form at first gear check at all ATDDEA events.

All riders are required to assist with various tasks at each event. If no preference is indicated, then a task will be assigned by the organising committee.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure the nominations are made correctly regarding the horses graded level at the time of entry close date.

Age Group Categories: -

12 and Under Competitions: riders must be 12 years of age or under as at 1st January of the current year.

Junior competitions: riders must be 16 years and under as at 1st January of the current year.

Senior classes: riders must be 17 years and over as at 1st January of the current year.

Scratchings & cancellations

A refund may only be made if documented proof (i.e. veterinary or medical certificate) is received by the Secretary within 7 days of the day of the event. 30% of the nomination fee will be withheld for administration.

Should the event be cancelled for any reason beyond the club's control, any refund will be at the absolute discretion of the ATDDEA Committee and will be based upon the amount of irretrievable expenses for that event.

Dress, Saddlery & Equipment

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure all dress, saddlery and equipment complies with <u>EA Dressage Rules</u> Section 5.

All riders must have horse registration numbers (HRN) or an EA horse number on their saddle cloths, halters (when outside yard). Owner name and mobile no. must be presented at yard/s

ATDDEA have allocated Closed Restricted horses an HRN, please see the draw. If you don't already have your number, please ask for your horse number for saddlecloths at Marquee well before your class.

Gear Check

Closed Restricted competitors are required to present for a Gear Check to a Steward or a Marshall prior to and immediately after each test.

Official riders must present for a Gear Check to an accredited Steward after each test and it is optional to have one before the test.

Riders cannot dismount or leave the competition area after a gear check, if you do you will be required to present for another Gear Check.

All helmets are required to be tagged with a current visible EA 'Helmet Tag'.

Grounds and Conditions

Warm-up will be allowed in one arena. Maximum of four riders in warm up arena at one time as per the draw order.

Please follow the warm-up protocols and please keep to the one-hour max warm-up time which includes lunging and riding.

Test Calling is allowed unless otherwise specified.

From 24hrs prior to the event starting, a horse may be ridden only by its nominated rider on the competition grounds. Refer to Section 3.12.2d

Camping

For Friday night camping, please pay Mareeba Rodeo Association, Camping Form

For Saturday night camping please pay via Nominate when you pay your entry fees.

All participants must comply with Kerribee Park rules and rules and conditions.

Dogs

Dogs must always be on a lead.

For those camping with a dog/s, you must camp to the north or east of the toilet block located opposite the care takers residence.

Please ensure you dog does not make excessive noise by barking or howling when you are present or absent from camping area.

Dogs are not allowed in the warm-up, lunging or in or near competition areas.
