Our new forms reflect the changes and I would ask that you make yourself familiar with the new ATDDEA Conditions of Entry which combine ATDDEA, EA, AON and KP rulings.

The **Conditions of Entry** form is available on the ATDDEA website (http://atddea.webs.com) along with all other relevant information from the club.

I would also encourage all members to visit the EA website http://www.equestrian.org.au and review the new **Dressage Rule Book**. The club will arrange for copies of sections 1, 2, 3, 6, 7 and 11 to be printed which will be available for a small donation to the club funds.

We also hold a stock of **Dressage Test booklets** which have useful diagrams of tests from preliminary to advanced.

If this seems a little overwhelming, join us for a little more clarification at the RSL on the Saturday evening of our practice weekend, the 19th March and Angela and the committee will take you through the information.

I look forward to seeing you all at our March event.

What's New

It is difficult knowing where to start with this, as there have been so many changes. These have come into play in light of insurance requirements and fairness to competitors and participants.

Michael's direction above is a good starting point. Michael has been in discussions with our hosts Jim and Shirley at Kerribee Park. To help implement some changes and to clarify 'what is where' there is a mud **map** of the venue that has been uploaded onto the ATDDEA website on the coordinators page (if any of our members can improve on this it would be welcomed).

The club's **Risk Management Plan** has been reviewed and again all members are encouraged to make themselves familiar with its contents. It is also available on the club website.

In 2010 Jim was kind enough to agree to 2 new arenas (arena 3 and arena 4). We have now introduced **New Arena Rules for Non-club Event Days**, so that members are able to hire them; details again on the website.

Staying with our venue, **work is continuing on the large yards**, which of course has been slowed by the weather. The large yards running parallel with the road opposite the caretaker's house are now complete; the yards facing the entrance road are still under construction. It's looking good so far!

In general, insurance issues have certainly been brought to the fore in recent months and our club is no exception.

EA/AON no longer offers day insurance for clubs. **Restricted Membership** for our club is now available for one event only. **The Conditions of Entry form** offers more details on this.

In line with ATDDEA and KP insurance recommendations **lunging will only be allowed in the fenced cutting yard** NO EXCEPTIONS.

Electric Fencing of any type will no longer be allowed at <u>any</u> club event.

One last word on our grounds. The club has purchased 2 dung carts, forks and rakes to make it easier for all members to clear up their horse's stall during the event and before leaving. This is not an option! No more Mr. Nice Guy on this – there will be a name and shame board at events and on the website.


Our events and the organisation thereof have seen some changes voted in by the AGM and committee.
